

SEUI

Seui is an agro pastoral town and the most important in the Barbagia of Seulo. It is located in the province of Nuoro and is 110 km far from the provincial capital. Seui has a population of 2170 inhabitants. In some of its neighbourhoods there are still many ancient houses built using the local stones (schist). In Seui tourists can still discover "real" Sardinia. The attractions are several: the museum, the Spanish prison, the churches in the town and in its countryside. The forest of Montarbu and the archaeological sites offer cues for mountain excursions, trekking, and naturalism. You can go to Seui on the little Green Train, with its old steam engine that crosses the most intact and richest forests of Sardinia in the mountains of Ogliastro.
