

The SPANISH PRISON

It was built in the 17th century (1647) and people were imprisoned here until the 70s.

Closed for good in 1975.

It is located in one of the most ancient areas of the village; it has got a structure square in shape and two floors. On the ground floor there is a solitary-confinement floor and the men's cell; the women's cell and the prison guard's room are on the floor above.

Outside there are two courtyards.

In 1983 the local council decided to renovate the prison that was restored respecting the former architecture.

In this prison different instruments of torture were used and the prisoners' conditions were very hard.

Owing to the presence of the Spanish prison new curses and oaths arose in Seui.
